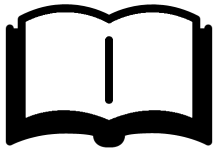

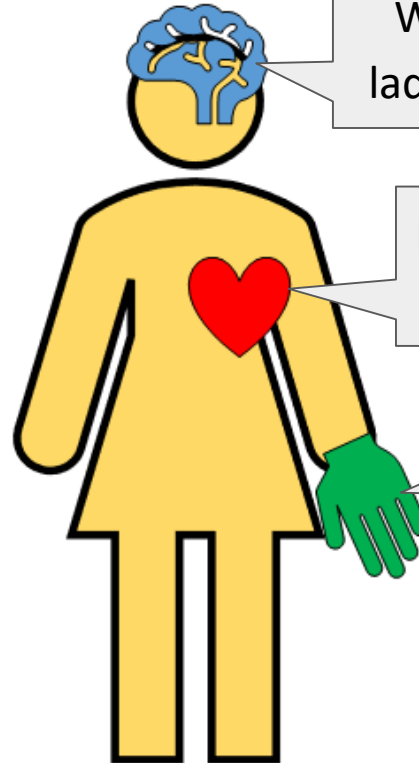

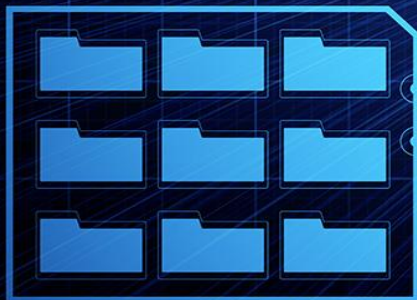
**Brief details.**

## Key Learning Points



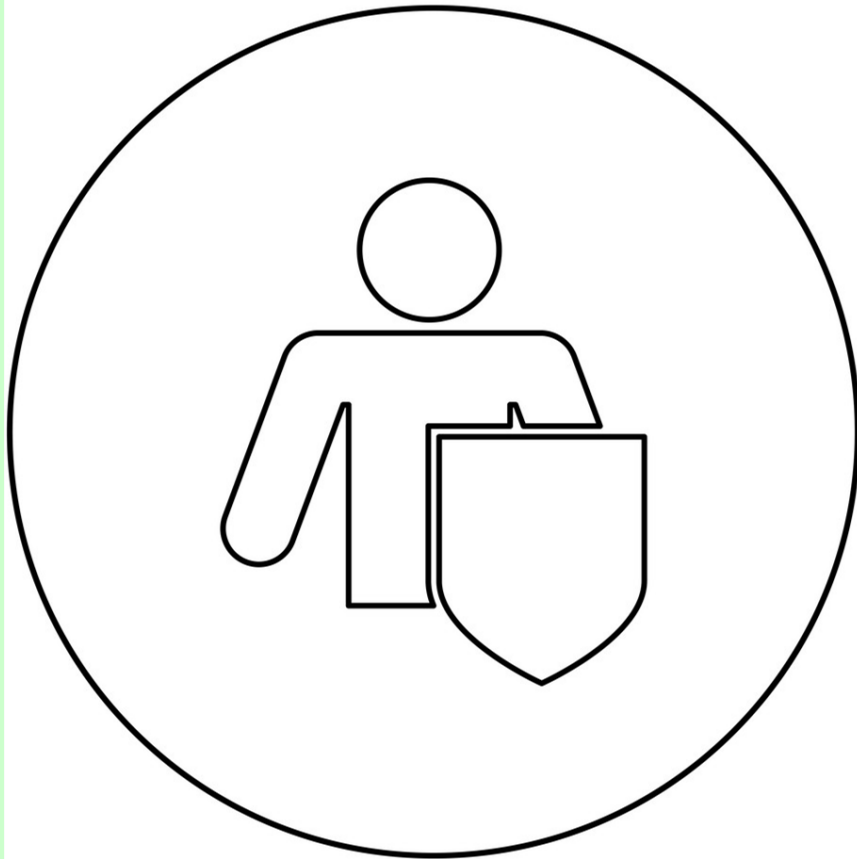
1. Online data can be easily utilised for a variety of positive and negative reasons


